EXECUTIVE DUTIES

- The City Council meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm and a quorum was confirmed by Mayor Tom Dickson. Mayor Dickson welcomed those in attendance for the meeting.
- Councilman Bill Caylor made a motion for Council Members to be excused into Executive Session to discuss personnel matters. The motion was seconded by Councilman Richard Lowe and the motion carried unanimously.
- Upon rejoining the Council meeting, a motion was made by Councilman Clyde Williams to appoint Lt. Kyle Moreno as new City of Varnell Police Chief. The motion was seconded by Councilman Bill Caylor and the motion carried unanimously. Mayor Dickson requested that Police Chief Moreno present to the Mayor and Council an update on how things are going as the new Chief of Police within the next 2 weeks at the June 16, 2020 council meeting.
- A commemorative plaque which noted thanks and years of service for Chief Grant from August 2003 through June, 2020 was presented to Chief Grant by Mayor Tom Dickson and City Council.

NEW BUSINESS

- Councilman Clyde Williams made a motion to extend the hazard pay for Varnell Police Officers until the end of July at which time the situation will be re-evaluated. Also noted that Tim Powell, Maintenance Supervisor should be added to the hazard pay list. The motion was seconded by Councilman Richard Lowe and carried unanimously.

- Mayor Dickson was appointed by the City Council to be the voting delegate from City of Varnell for GMA business meetings.
- Georgia Municipal Association will be offering training as online classes within the next few weeks since annual conference will not be held due to the Covid-19 issues.
- There being no further notice, Councilman Clyde Williams made a motion to adjourn. Councilman Bill Caylor seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.
