AGENDA, MINUTES AND FINANCIAL REPORT

The annexation for Clogger Properties was tabled in order to have a public hearing. The hearing will have To take place before this annexation can be adopted.

The floor was opened for public comment and a few of the residences voiced their opinion on dissolving the Police Department and the issue. David Owens spoke briefly regarding the non-binding referendum on the November 2017 ballot. Jan Pourquoi spoke as well regarding what he believes to be double coverage in having a Police Department when Whitfield County Sherriff's Department is already covering the Varnell area.

David Owens made a motion to have the non-binding referendum placed on the November ballot. Ashlee Godfrey Stated that the council would have to have a second meeting in order to put the referendum regarding the dissolving Of the Police Department and omitting property tax. At this point, she recused herself from the meeting and no Further vote could be taken from the council due to a lack of quorum. Therefore, Mayor Hulsey declared adjournment To the meeting at 8:50 pm.
